The experience we had with both these officers, I know, will have a big impact and will allow me to retain that trust. Excerpt from Letter: Constables Bassam Chaaraoui and Sara Nesbit took time to hear, listen to, understand, and worked to build trust with my brother, and with me on a recent call. Importantly, they did this by validating the realities my brother was experiencing in the situation. They spelled out clearly what they can and cannot do within their role in this situation as police. They helped us understand what the landlord can and cannot do within the Landlord and Tenants Act. When it became known late in our conversation that my brother and I are members of a First Nation, both Csts. Chaaraoui's and Nesbitt's approaches seemed to shift towards being even more open and focused on understanding. It was after that that they helped us brainstorm immediate solutions of how to deal with the next steps (like where my brother could stay after the eviction move was done) and once their police involvement was done. They, especially Cst. Chaaraoui, used an increasingly conciliatory, cooperative, and warm tone and approach that helped me feel like they genuinely were interested in helping everyone come away from this situation as best as everyone could, given the circumstances. I am grateful for both Csts. Chaaraoui's and Nesbitt's involvement in this situation, and how gracefully and diplomatically they handled it.
