## Statistics


Sharing of our statistics continues to demonstrate the success and positive impact of Crime Stoppers. Year to date numbers continue to demonstrate an impactful number of tips being generated. Our 2023 tip volume is down slightly from our 2022 volume. We received 319 anonymous tips in March 2023. These tips have helped our law enforcement partners with two arrests; four criminal cases being cleared and two criminal charges.
