The dispatch agent who took my call was efficient, professional, clear and concise. Within moments there was an immediate response from OPS officers who quickly sectioned off the area where the shooting occurred. They were cruisers and officers in place, visible and interviewing witnesses but also speaking to community members. I went over to speak to the officers briefly and they provided me with information, and were very sympathetic, understanding and thoughtful. Please let the officers who were on the scene today know their efforts and client service were greatly appreciated today by us. In our over 20 years of living in this neighbourhood my wife and I have never heard gunshots, as you can imagine this was very unsettling. The response from your officers made us feel safe and secure knowing that they were in the neighbourhood, on the job, and making sure that we were protected. We want your membership to know that they are appreciated and that their presence, dedication and hard work go a long way to helping the rest of us feel safe, secure and able to go about our daily lives even on days like today.
