#### APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL AND PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATIONS:

The Owner wants to convey a portion of its property to the abutting property owner to the east, known municipally as 60 Pontiac Street.

### CONSENT IS REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

The Owner requires the Committee's consent for a lot line adjustment.

The land to be severed is shown as Part 4 on a Draft 4R-Plan filed with the applications, is landlocked, has a depth of 3.35 metres and contains an area of 83.0 square metres.

The land to be retained, shown as Part 5 on said plan, will have a frontage of 16.15 metres, an irregular depth of 22.86 metres and a lot area of 382.4 square metres.

The owner of 60 Pontiac Street has filed a related Consent Application (D08-01-23/B-00196) as part of a mutual land exchange. Approval of these applications will have the effect of creating parcels of land that will not be in conformity with the requirements of the Zoning By-law and therefore, a Minor Variance Application (D08-02-23/A-00186) has been filed and will be heard concurrently with this application.

#### **REQUESTED VARIANCES:**

The Owner/Applicant requires the Committee's authorization for minor variances from the Zoning By-law as follows:

- a) To permit a reduced lot area of 385.8 square metres, whereas the By-law requires a minimum lot area of 450 square metres.
- b) To permit a reduced interior side yard setback of 0.77 metres, whereas the Bylaw requires a minimum interior side yard setback of 1.2 metres.
- c) To permit a reduced setback for an accessory building in a rear yard of 0.23 metres, whereas the By-law requires a minimum setback for an accessory building in a rear yard of 0.6 metres.

**IF YOU DO NOT PARTICIPATE** in the hearing, it may proceed in your absence, and you will not receive any further notice of the proceedings.

**IF YOU WANT TO BE NOTIFIED OF THE DECISION** following the hearing, and of any subsequent appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal, submit a written request to the Committee.
