Clayton supported my efforts to advocate for myself to get the medication and help that I so desperately needed. Today, mentally, I'm so much better. Cst. Clayton and his unit do so much more for our area than arrest criminals; they care about the residents and try to assist them if possible in any way they can. Cst. Clayton is even well known on two Facebook sites concerning our area. People send him camera footage and there is so much praise for him and his unit. I wish all Ottawa communities had officers like Constable Clayton and his team. Thank you.
