Summary of oral submissions

The Applicant/Owner as represented by Chris Clarke, ZanderPlan Inc provided an overview of the Application and responded to questions from Committee. A copy of the slide presentation is filed with the Office of the City Clerk.

The Committee heard from the following delegations:

1. Tim Parsons spoke to a slide deck, a copy of which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk. The presentation touched on concerns related to environmental impacts, increased truck traffic and suggested additional restriction should be added to the amendment.
2. Marc Sauve, Metcalfe Community Association also expressed concerns with increased truck traffic and how the traffic flow could be alternately routed.
3. Anne Parsons expressed concerns with the proposal and the increase in truck traffic.
4. Lynda Muckle noted approving this application to rezone to allow for industrial use will set a precedent in the rural community, also expressing concerns with the increase in truck traffic as a result.
