## **INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT**

### **Qualified Opinion**

We have audited the Financial Statement - Auditor's Report Candidate - Form 4 ("Form 4") of Clarke Kelly Municipal Election Campaign, for the campaign period May 16, 2022 to January 3, 2023 relating to the City of Ottawa Municipal Election held on October 24, 2022, prepared in accordance with Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph section of our report, the accompanying Form 4 of Clarke Kelly Municipal Election Campaign for the period ended January 03, 2023 is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

### **Basis for Qualified Opinion**

Due to the inherent nature of election campaign transactions, the completeness of the various categories of income and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of income and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of Clarke Kelly Municipal Election Campaign and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income, expenses, and period surplus/deficit for the period ended January 03, 2023.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of Form 4* section of our report. We are independent of Clarke Kelly Municipal Election Campaign in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of Form 4 in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

### **Other Matter**

Without modifying our opinion, we note that Form 4 is prepared to assist the Candidate and Clarke Kelly Municipal Election Campaign to comply with the financial reporting provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and as such, may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report and the attached Form 4 is intended solely for use of the Candidate of Clarke Kelly Municipal Election Campaign, the City Clerk, and the Ontario Ministry of Municipal Affairs and should not be distributed to or used by parties other than these specified users or for any other purpose.

### **Responsibilities of the Candidate for Form 4**

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation of this Form 4 in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and for such internal control as the Candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the Form 4 that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### **Auditors' Responsibility for the Audit of Form 4**

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether Form 4 as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditors' report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Form 4.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of Form 4, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
