

Update on the Community Safety & Policing Act



April 1, 2024, has been proclaimed as the official date on which the Community Safety & Policing Act (CSPA) will come into force.

Currently, there are 26 Ontario Regulations under the CSPA that have been filed. They are subject to change. More are expected to be filed; however, the dates are unknown.

Change to Province's Legislative Framework



Once the CSPA comes into Force it will replace the Police Service Act. Significant changes include:

- Updated duties and authorities of the Solicitor General
- Establishing the authority of the Inspector General of Policing
- Updated requirements for the delivery of policing
- Updates to provincial standards and training requirements
- Changes to the police discipline process and provincial oversight bodies
