## AGREEMENT TO RENEW AND EXTEND THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

(Hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement")

The Ottawa Police Service Board

And

City of Ottawa Transit Services
(Formerly known as "City of Ottawa Transportation Services," as indicated in the Agreement signed on July 31, 2018)

Regarding the Appointment of OC Transpo Special Constable Unit Officers as Special Constables

Whereas the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019 (CSPA) came into effect April 1, 2024, and has replaced the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15.

**Whereas** there are new regulations as part of the *CSPA* coming into force, including regulations related to special constables.

**Whereas** the Parties anticipate that the new Memorandum of Understanding, aligned with the requirements under the *CSPA*, will be completed in the coming months.

Whereas the Agreement will end on May 31, 2024, and OC Transpo has identified areas where additional authorities could be considered before entering a new Agreement.

In view of the above and the continuing need for cooperation, the Parties to this Agreement have agreed to renew and extend the term of the Memorandum of Understanding concerning the Appointment of OC Transpo Special Constable Unit Officers as Special Constables signed July 31, 2018, as follows:

- 1. The Agreement will be renewed and extended for a period of four (4) months (until September 30, 2024).
- 2. The renewal and extension of the Agreement shall be retroactive to May 31, 2024.
- 3. This Agreement may be amended or extended further by written agreement of the Parties.

This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature of the duly authorized representatives of the Parties.
