BACKGROUND

On December 7, 2022, City Council approved the Appointment Policy as part of the report 2022-2026 Council Governance Review. At it's meeting of April 12, 2023, Council approved the report Appointments to the Board of Health, which included a reserve member to fill any vacancy arising between recruitment processes.
