



New Bus Operator Hiring Since 2022

- 828 hired as trainees --> 615 graduated --> 519 still active as bus operators (net)
- 75% of trainees graduated
- 84% of graduates are still bus operators
- Reasons for attrition:
 - Resignation
 - Involuntary termination
 - Moved to other positions in Transit



- Data current as of September 30, 2024
- Customer injury rate: 0.55 per million trips, improved from previous years
- Top 3 customer injury factors: braking, bus in motion, disembarking
- 584 occurrences reported by employees
- Top three employee occurrence types: stressful event, struck/caught, motor vehicle incident
- Preventable rate for vehicle collisions is 1.13 collisions per 100,000 kms
- Red-light infractions are on track for a decrease from 2023









Service Delivery






O-Train Line 1




Bus Service Delivery
