

**Document 1 – By-law to Require a By-election**

**BY-LAW NO. 2025-XXX**

A by-law of the City of Ottawa requiring a by-election to be held to fill the vacancy in the Office of the Member of Council for Ward 20 (Osgoode).

WHEREAS the Member of Council for Ward 20 (Osgoode) filed a written resignation with the City Clerk of the municipality on March 14, 2025, pursuant to Section 260 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of March 26, 2025, declared the Ward 20 (Osgoode) seat to be vacant pursuant to Section 262 of *the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, as amended, and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 263 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, as amended, the City Council may pass a by-law indicating a by-election is required to fill the vacancy in the Office of a Member of Council; and

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the City of Ottawa hereby requires a by-election to be held to fill the vacancy in the Office of the Member of Ward 20 (Osgoode) in the City of Ottawa in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched.*, as amended.
