BACKGROUND

The Delegation of Authority By-law (By-law No. 2024-265) approved by City Council on May 29, 2024 delegates the authority to staff at four levels of management to approve and conclude real estate transactions involving the acquisition or sale of an interest in land or property. Sections 60 to 67 of the By-law describe the types of transactions allowed under the delegation of authority including fee simple acquisitions, easements, rights of way, leases, joint use and maintenance agreements, licenses, and consents to enter.

The Interim Director, Housing Solutions and Investment Services, is authorized to approve, amend, extend and execute agreements with the federal or provincial government provided that such agreements are related to supportive and affordable housing development, are consistent with the departmental mandate and are at no cost to the City, with the exception of associated operational and administrative costs that are within approved budgets.

Real Estate delegations are subject to the provisions of this by-law as well as the Acquisition of Real Property Policy, the Disposal of Real Property Policy, the Leasing Policy and Procedures approved by Council. By-law 2024-265 requires staff to report the exercise of delegated authority to the Finance and Corporate Services Committee on a semi-annual basis.

DISCUSSION

The Housing Solutions and Investment Services (HSIS) certifies that all transactions approved under delegated authority for the period of 1 July 2024 to 31 Decembre 2024 comply with the Delegation of Authority By-law and the Disposal, Acquisition and Leasing of Real Property policies. These transactions are listed in Document 1.

Prior to transaction approval, HSIS staff confirms with the Finance and Corporate Services Department staff that the appropriate funds are available in the budget. The availability of funds is a condition and requirement of approval under delegated authority.
