Dear Peter Scislowski:

I am writing in response to your application to be a special constable employer under the *Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019* (CSPA).

Following a thorough review of your application, I am pleased to advise that you have met all the prescribed requirements under the CSPA and, effective November 1, 2024, the City of Ottawa, Transit Services, is authorized to employ special constables under the CSPA.

Please ensure that all special constables that you employ adhere to all the requirements outlined in the CSPA and the supporting regulations related to special constables. Additionally, please ensure that you maintain compliance with the obligations of a special constable employer under the CSPA.

Further, section 97 (8) in the CSPA requires a special constable employer to promptly notify the Ministry of the Solicitor General of any changes in the information provided in their application for an authorization to employ special constables, or of any changes that affect the ability of the special constable employer to meet the prescribed requirements under the CSPA. Failure to provide this notice may result in the revocation of this authorization.
