

BY-LAW 2025-XXX

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to amend various by-laws respecting the participation of licensed vendors at special events and block parties.

1. Section 1 of By-law No. 2005-358, entitled “A by-law of the City of Ottawa respecting vendors on highways.” is amended by adding the following definitions:

“Highway Events By-law” means the Highway Events By-law (No. 2025-XXX) of the City of Ottawa, or any successor by-law;

“Special Events By-law” means the Special Events By-law (No. 2025-XXX) of the City of Ottawa, or any successor by-law;

2. Section 4 of said By-law No. 2005-358 is amended by repealing clause (b) and (c) and substituting the following clauses:

(b) Any Itinerant Seller, Mobile Refreshment Vehicle, Mobile Canteen, Mobile Refreshment Cart, Refreshment Stand vending at a Special Event authorized under authority of a permit issued pursuant to the Special Events By-law and who holds a valid business license issued by the City;

(c) One Itinerant Seller, Mobile Refreshment Vehicle, Mobile Canteen, Mobile Refreshment Cart or Refreshment Stand vending at a block party authorized under authority of a permit issued pursuant to the Highway Events By-law and who holds a valid business license issued by the City;

3. Section 4 of By-law 2007-478, entitled “A by-law of the City of Ottawa respecting designated spaces for street vendors and to repeal By-law Number 300-96 of the old City of Ottawa.”, as amended, is amended by adding the following definitions:

“Highway Events By-law” means the Highway Events By-law (No. 2025-XXX) of the City of Ottawa, or any successor by-law;

“Special Events By-law” means the Special Events By-law (No. 2025-XXX) of the City of Ottawa, or any successor by-law;

4. Section 16 of said By-law 2007-478 is amended by adding the following subsections:

(7) Any licensee vending within the confines of permitted special event site during the permitted dates and times, as authorized under the Special Events By-law.

- (8) One licensee vending within the confines of permitted block party, as authorized under the Highway Events By-law.

5. Section 16 of Schedule 21, Relating to Itinerant Sellers, of By-law No. 2002-189 entitled "A by-law of the City of Ottawa respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of certain businesses", as amended, is amended by inserting the following subsection:

- (27) Despite subsections (14), (15), (16), (17), (18) and (19), licensees participating in a special event may operate subject to the terms and conditions of the permit issued under the Special Events By-law.

6. Section 7 of Schedule 23, Relating to Mobile Canteens, of said By-law No. 2002-189 is amended by inserting the following subsection:

- (10) Despite subsection (7), a person may vend within the confines of a special event site, subject to the terms and conditions of the special event permit issued under the Special Events By-law.

7. Section 7 of Schedule 25, Relating to Refreshment Stands, of said By-law 2002-189 is amended by repealing subsection (9) and substituting the following section:

- (9) Despite subsection (8), vendors participating in a special event held pursuant to the Special Event By-law are exempt.

8. Section 7 of Schedule 28, Relating to Rural Refreshment Vehicles, Rural Mobile Canteens, and Rural Refreshment Stands, of said By-law 2002-189 is amended by inserting the following subsection:

- (14) Despite subsection (8), vendors participating in a special event held pursuant to the Special Event By-law are exempt.
