For the information of Council, the following items were considered by the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee under Delegated Authority, at its meeting of June 5, 2025:

<u>Presentation – Planning, Development and Building Services Department – Transportation Master Plan – Rural Lens – Verbal Update</u>

Orléans East-Cumberland (Ward 1); West Carleton-March (Ward 5); Orléans South-Navan (Ward 19); Osgoode (Ward 20); and Rideau-Jock (Ward 21)

Direction to Staff (Councillor D. Brown):

The 2023 Transportation Master Plan (TMP) Active Transportation Project list includes a feasibility study to provide active transportation facilities on Manotick Main Street between Eastman Avenue and Century Road East. As part of the recently released draft 2025 TMP Capital Infrastructure Plan, this feasibility study is identified as a first phase priority. In the next few years, there is also an upcoming resurfacing project for Manotick Main Street which offers potential coordination opportunities.

Given the above considerations, staff are directed to initiate work on the feasibility study for Manotick Main Street as soon as possible after Council's approval of the Capital Infrastructure Plan and project priorities in July 2025, and as part of the study, staff consult with community stakeholders and residents, and identify opportunities to coordinate with the planned resurfacing project.
