Mid-Term Report 2023-2026

French Language Services Advisory Committee (FLSAC)

May 8, 2025

BACKGROUND

Early in its mandate, the French Language Services Advisory Committee (FLSAC) developed a three-year work plan. The plan guides the FLSAC's efforts to fulfill its mandate of making recommendations to Ottawa City Council about issues that impact the implementation of the Bilingualism Policy and the latter's application to all City policies, services, programs and initiatives. Of course, the Committee must ensure that its activities align with and complement City Council's strategic priorities.

With this mandate in mind, the members of the FLSAC selected the following goals as part of their 2023-2026 work plan:

1. Support an approach that enhances municipal programs available to residents;
2. Continue to raise staff awareness of the importance of providing an active offer of bilingual services;
3. Support economic growth and resiliency in our bilingual City; and,
4. Support the recruitment and hiring of bilingual City staff.

In 2024, the French Language Services Advisory Committee, with the support of the French Language Services Division, extended invitations to the Departments listed in the attached Document 1 (Work Plan with Progress Update for 2025).

Furthermore, the FLSAC's mandate includes being available as a resource to staff to provide input on matters being pursued to achieve Council's strategic priorities.

Accordingly, the FLSAC accepted an invitation in their 2023-2026 term from the Departments listed in Document 2 (Summary of Staff Consultations for 2023-2025).

At these meetings, the FLSAC received presentations from City staff, asked follow-up questions, and provided feedback to staff, including written recommendations to staff in some cases. This was done either by adopting, at a later FLSAC meeting, a formal report drafted by a member or a working group responsible for the given matter, or a written summary of Member comments, compiled by the FLSAC Chair or a member of FLSAC as assigned by the Chair.

DISCUSSION

A summary of the FLSAC's progress on its 2023-2026 work plan is attached to this report as Document 1.

A summary of staff consultations with the FLSAC over their 2023-2026 term is included in Document 2.

Additionally, the FSLAC submitted comments on the draft budgets for the 2023 and 2024 fiscal years, in each instance, providing written comments to the Finance and Corporate Services Committee.
