ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

Infrastructure Engineering

- The Planning, Development and Building Services Department will do a complete review of grading and servicing during the building permit process.
- At the time of building permit application, a grading/servicing plan prepared by a Professional Engineer, Ontario Land surveyor or a Certified Engineering Technologist will be required.
- Existing grading and drainage patterns must not be altered.
- The surface storm water runoff including the roof water must be self contained and directed to the City Right-of-Way, not onto abutting private properties as approved by Planning, Development and Building Services Department.
- Encroachment on or alteration to any easement is not permitted without authorization from easement owner(s).

Planning Forestry

There are no tree-related concerns with the requested variances. Through preconsultation it was determined that no work is proposed within the Critical Root Zones of existing trees. Tree protection fencing must be installed and maintained in accordance with the City's tree protection specifications for the duration of construction.

Right of Way Management

The Right-of-Way Management Department has no concerns with the proposed Minor Variance Application. The existing private approach is not being modified and is leading to a legal parking space in the updated garage.

Transportation Engineering
