BY-LAW NO. 2025-

A by-law of the City of Ottawa amending By-law No. 50 of 2000 respecting the procurement of goods, services and construction for the City of Ottawa.

The Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. Section 10 of By-law No. 50 of 2000, titled, "A by-law respecting the purchasing of goods, services and construction for the City of Ottawa", as amended, is deleted and replaced with the following text:

Section 10 – Trade Agreements

- 1. The federal and provincial governments are signatories to various trade agreements that bind the City of Ottawa. Procurement by the City may be subject to the provisions of these trade agreements.
- 2. The Chief Procurement Officer may implement any federal or provincial trade policy that guides the City's interpretation of existing trade obligations.
- 3. When an applicable trade agreement or federal or provincial trade policy is in conflict with this By-law, the trade agreement or federal or provincial trade policy shall take precedence.
- 4. Supply Services shall advise Directors where a procurement action may not conform to an applicable trade agreement or trade policy as early as possible in the procurement process.
- 2. This by-law enters into force on , 2025.
