	Increase use of Letters of Undertaking	Number of new Site Plan Control applications that use Letters of Undertaking, versus legal agreement
<p><b>Housing construction increased, with emphasis in urban and transit-oriented areas</b></p>	Increase in number of building permits	Number of building permits issued
	Increase in number of building permits for Transit-Oriented Development	Number of building permits issued in Transit Oriented Development
	Increase in number of pre-set private infill designs approved	Number of available private infill pre-set designs (except singles, unless a coach house)
	Increase in Additional Dwelling Units	Number of building permits issued for Additional Dwelling Units
	Increase in number of building permits for 3 to 4 storey buildings	Number of building permits issued for 3 to 4 storey buildings
<p><b>Affordable housing availability is increased</b></p>	Increase in building permits for affordable housing	Number of building permits issued for new affordable housing units
	Increase in building permits for supportive housing	Number of building permits for new supportive housing units
