Staff will be reviewing the methodology and updating the financials that feed into it, and also producing a "white paper" about the cost of travel that discusses the methodology and related issues. The first public consultations in November/December 2019 introduced the subject, and the next milestone will be a Q1 2020 "white paper" for the public for review and provide feedback. Based on review of the feedback staff receives, the TMP Update team will produce the updated Cost of Travel model itself in Q2 2020. At that point, with the updated model in hand, the public-facing calculator as a subsequent step will be pursued.</p>
