Report Recommendations

1. That Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee recommend Council approve an amendment to Zoning By-law 2008-250 for 4837 Albion Road (Hard Rock Ottawa Raceway and Casino) to amend Exception 528r and Schedule S381, as detailed in Documents 4 and 5, to enable a revised layout at the expanded casino, by:

- a. permitting a new location for the proposed hotel;
- b. permitting outdoor commercial patios, minimum 6-metre wide drive aisles, and front yard parking with a minimum 3metre landscaped strip;
- c. clarifying the intent of the previous by-law by removing text; and
- d. revising the holding provisions.

WHEREAS supporting the Hard Rock Ottawa development at 4837
Albion Road is an action of 2019-2022 Term of Council Priorities; and,

WHEREAS the Hard Rock Ottawa Raceway and Casino Expansion at 4837 Albion Road is located adjacent to the future extension of Earl Armstrong Road from Albion Road to Hawthorne Road as identified in the Transportation Master Plan's Road Network Concept;

WHEREAS the Environmental Assessment for the Earl Armstrong

Extension was completed in 2019 to protect the corridor for the future
road extension and respond effectively to the development application
at 4837 Albion Road;

WHEREAS the implementation of the Earl Armstrong Extension is not identified as part of the TMP's Affordable Road Network to 2031 and correspondingly has no funding allocated in the City's Long-Range Financial Plan; and

WHEREAS road projects outside the City's Long-Range Financial Plan are not eligible for development charge funding or a front-ending agreement;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Agriculture and Rural Affairs

Committee recommend that Council direct staff in Transportation

Services to review the implementation timing for Earl Armstrong

Extension, from Albion Road to Bank Street, and look for ways to advance this segment as part of the ongoing Transportation Master Plan update.
