## BACKGROUND

The Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee, at its meeting of 5 April 2018, approved the following motion added to the agenda pursuant to 89(3) of the Procedure By-law (being By-law no. 2016-377).

*"Whereas in 2011 the City of Ottawa opened a new community centre at 6020 Piperville Road to replace the aging facility at 5065 Thunder Road to serve the residents of Carlsbad Springs;*

*Whereas the City has invested heavily in the relocation of the community centre and recently completed the relocation of the outdoor rink to 6020 Piperville Road;*

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*Whereas the NCC owns the lands surrounding the 6020 Piperville Road site which are included in the Greenbelt;*

*Whereas there is a desire within the community to consolidate all recreational activities around a central hub in the village;*

*Whereas the former community centre building located at 5065 Thunder Road is at the end of its life;*

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee recommend Council:

- 1) *Investigate the feasibility and cost of leasing additional land from the NCC for access to users of the recreational facilities at 6020 Piperville Road in Carlsbad Springs;*
- 2) *Investigate the feasibility of disposing of the property at 5065 Thunder Road in Carlsbad Springs to provide the source of funds for such a lease and further recreational development at 6020 Piperville Road;*
- 3) *Return to committee and council with an implementation plan for the above by Q4 2018."*
