Report Recommendation

Transportation Committee recommend Council approve that the City include the Hydro wire burying on Hawthorne Avenue within the Hawthorne/Greenfield /Main Street Reconstruction project scope and estimates, subject to funding.

At the outset, the Chair indicated Councillor G. Darouze would be introducing a motion. Prior to the motion being put on the floor, Councillor J. Sudds provided some background comments. She referenced a special area levy applied in Kanata in 2010 to bury hydro lines that the policy did not support. The purpose of a special area levy is so taxpayers pay for services that are not available city wide. There is a policy in place to ensure equitability across the city.
