BACKGROUND

Every year, Ottawa Public Health (OPH) publishes an Annual Report as a means to showcase successes of the past year, demonstrate fiscal responsibility to its funders and thank community partners for their commitment in collaborating to improve the health of Ottawa residents. The *Ontario Public Health Organizational Standards* (OPHS) promote organizational excellence, establish the foundation for effective and efficient program and service delivery and contribute to a public health sector with a greater focus on performance, accountability and sustainability. As stipulated in the *OPHS*, the Board shall produce an annual report to the general public, which includes a description of programs and operation of the public health unit. In addition to its duties and responsibilities under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act*, the Board shall, at the request of the city, make an annual report to the City on the Board's operations, pursuant to the *City of Ottawa Act, 1999*, section 12, subsection 7.
