 - c) The south side of Gardenway Drive between Paradise Crescent (west) and approximately 40m west of Paradise Crescent (west); and
 - The south side of Gardenway Drive between Paradise d) Crescent (east) and approximately 50m west of Paradise Crescent (east).
- 2. Approve that any remaining funds, as a result of the reduced project scope, be re-allocated towards the implementation of another sidewalk project in the Ottawa Pedestrian Plan.

BACKGROUND

The Transportation Committee at its meeting of 7 June 2017, approved the following motion, which was added to the agenda pursuant to subsection 89(3) of the Procedure By-law (By-law 2016-377):

WHEREAS City Council approved the Ottawa Pedestrian Plan in November 2013; and

WHEREAS sidewalks provide safe connectivity to pedestrians of all ages and abilities within the community to transit, schools, employment and recreational facilities; and,

WHEREAS the 2013 Ottawa Pedestrian Plan identifies a sidewalk on Gardenway Drive, from Thicket Way to Portobello Boulevard, as a Phase 1 Project: and,

WHEREAS Phase 1 Ottawa Pedestrian Plan Projects are identified as a Strategic Initiative in the 2015-2018 Term of Council Priorities; and

WHEREAS funding for the Gardenway Drive sidewalk was approved in the 2016 Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS residents along the roadway do not believe that construction of a continuous sidewalk along Gardenway Drive is required; and,

WHEREAS the residents' priority for Gardenway Drive sidewalks is limited to segments that directly serve local bus stops only;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Transportation Committee recommend that Council direct staff to reduce the scope of the Gardenway Drive Project to include the following segments that directly serve local bus stops:

- 1. The south side of Gardenway Drive between Thickey Way and Esplanade Avenue;
- 2. The south side of Gardenway Drive between Boake Street and Lejeune Drive;
- 3. The south side of Gardenway Drive between Paradise Crescent (west) and approximately 40m west of Paradise Crescent (west); and
- 4. The south side of Gardenway Drive between Paradise Crescent (east) and approximately 50m west of Paradise Crescent (east).
