Councillor El-Chantiry inquired if the item was in compliance with the Community Design Plan. Robin van de Lande, Planner II, stated that the CDP does not refer to the exemption for the servicing of those lots. The CDP contemplated full servicing of those lands. The secondary plan exempted those small areas in the hope for industrial development but most has become residential with a small amount of industrial which can be on private services.
