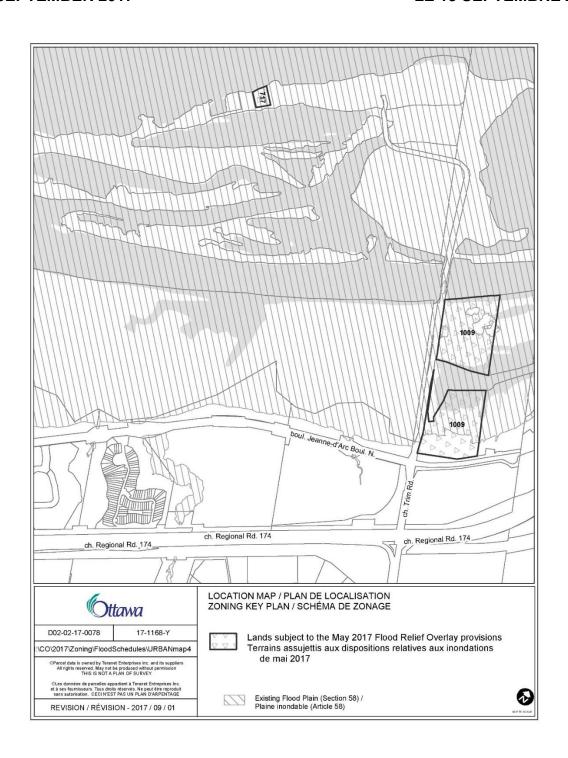
WHEREAS Report ACS2017-PIE-EDP-0031 recommends zoning amendments to provide relief to property owners affected by the May 2017 flood;
