Councillor Diane Deans, Chair of Crime Prevention Ottawa (CPO) gave some introductory remarks on the work of CPO and introduced Nancy Worsfold, Manager of Crime Prevention Ottawa. Nancy introduced the team that would be assisting her in the presentation:

Following the presentation Committee members had a variety of questions of the speakers dealing with but not limited to the following:

Does CPO support and believe that Community Policing is important? They feel

it is very important and getting better. The Ottawa Police Service has received funds from the province that should assist in expanding.

An important part of keeping youth crime down is getting employment. Funds were made available (\$400,000) for youth programs and Dan Chenier, General Manager of Recreation, Cultural and Facility Services will provide information on the 5 groups who received that funding.

Discussion took place on quantity of guns in the Ottawa area and where they may have come from. Investigating Officer with Ottawa Police, Carl Cartwright stated that most were coming from the U.S.
