That Council appoint Councillors Darouze and Brockington as the City of Ottawa's Representatives on the Rideau Corridor Landscape Strategy Steering Committee for the 2018-2022 Term of Council.

BACKGROUND

The Finance and Economic Development Committee, at its meeting of September 10, 2019, approved the following motion to add to the agenda pursuant to 89(3) of the Procedures By-law (being By-law no. 2019-8):

That the Finance and Economic Development Committee (FEDC) waive the *Rules of Procedure* to add the Rideau Corridor Landscape Strategy on today's FEDC agenda due to the fact that confirmation is required by the end of September 2019.

WHEREAS in 2010, Parks Canada formally created the Rideau Corridor Landscape Strategy to steer its commitment to undertake an assessment of the visual character of the Rideau Canal Corridor; and

WHEREAS the Rideau Corridor Landscape Strategy is led by a Steering Committee composed of representatives from Municipalities along the Rideau Corridor and other parties with an influence on planning and development along the corridor including, Parks Canada, the National Capital Commission, the Province of Ontario, First Nations and Conservation Authorities; and

WHEREAS the City of Ottawa appoints one urban representative and one rural representative to the Rideau Corridor Landscape Strategy Steering Committee, and is required to appoint new representatives following the 2018 Election; and

WHEREAS Councillors George Darouze and Riley Brockington have agreed to serve as the Rural and Urban representatives, respectively; and

WHEREAS Parks Canada has requested confirmation of the City of Ottawa's representatives by the end of September 2019;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Finance and Economic Development Committee recommend that Council appoint Councillors Darouze and Brockington as the City of Ottawa's Representatives on the Rideau Corridor Landscape Strategy Steering Committee for the 2018-2022 Term of Council.

DISCUSSION
