BACKGROUND

This employee requires Special Constable status to fulfill the duties of their role as the Supervisor, Criminal Intelligence Monitors. The re-appointment ensures that this employee can carry out their assigned duties. An application is made to the Ministry of

Community Safety and Correctional Services to have them re-appointed as a Special Constable pursuant to Section 53 of the Police Services Act (PSA). The Board appoints the employee as a Special Constable upon approval by the Ministry for a five-year period or until the appointee is no longer in the employ of the Ottawa Police Service (OPS). Upon the termination of employment, the OPS advises the Ministry to terminate the appointment.

DISCUSSION

The Board is being asked to approve the re-appointment of this Special Constable in accordance with the above noted process.

This re-appointment will provide the employee with the necessary powers under the PSA to complete his duties with the Intelligence Section of the OPS.

Approval has been obtained from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services for the appointments of this OPS member as a Special Constable.
