BY-LAW NO. 2020-XX

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to authorize the use of an alternative voting method for the 2020 municipal by-election in Ward 19.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, subsection 42(1)(b) provides that the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws authorizing the use of an alternative voting method, such as voting by mail, that does not require electors to attend a voting place in order to vote;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* subsection 42(5) provides that when a by-law authorizing the use of an alternative voting method is in effect, that section 43 (advance vote) and section 44 (voting proxies) shall only apply if the by-law so specifies;

AND WHEREAS due to the ongoing COVID 19 pandemic, the City of Ottawa deems it in the interest of the City to pass a by-law to authorize electors to use an alternative voting method, being a special paper ballot which may be returned by mail and does not require electors to attend a voting place in order to vote;

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

- 1. The Council hereby authorizes electors to use an alternative voting method for the 2020 Ward 19 municipal by-election, being a special paper ballot established by the City Clerk which must be returned to the Elections Office by 4:30pm on October 5, 2020.
- 2. The City Clerk shall determine the dates, hours and locations during which the advance vote is held and shall establish the criteria for voting proxies to authorize proxy voting at a voting place but not proxy voting for the special paper ballot.
