## **BACKGROUND**

Every year, the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) hosts a National Annual Education Conference. This year, the Ontario Branch will be the hosts to welcome inspectors from across Canada and interested stakeholders to the Educational Conference. This year's conference will be held in Ottawa, providing an opportunity for Members of the Board to learn more about the day-to-day business of Public Health Inspectors. Ottawa Public Health's Environment Health Protection Branch has led the planning and organizing of the conference on behalf of CIPHI's Ontario branch.

This year will mark the 81<sup>st</sup> Annual Educational Conference, taking place September 13-16, 2015. The conference themed "Looking Back, Moving Forward", will explore historical overviews, lessons learned, and visions and strategies to meet the environmental and public health challenges of the future.
