REPORT RECOMMENDATION

Further to deliberations of the Selection Panel, that Council approve the appointment of Leo A. (Sandy) Smallwood to the Ottawa Police Services Board, including waiver of Section 2.1 of the Appointment Policy as described in this report, with the term to be effective upon Council approval and to expire with the term of Council.

BACKGROUND

The Council-approved Appointment Policy for Citizen Members of City Advisory Committees, Boards, Commissions, Task Forces and Authorities, approved by City Council on December 5th, 2018, outlines the process and requirements for recruiting citizen members to the City's advisory committees and boards, as well as external boards, commissions and authorities for which members are required.

DISCUSSION

The Selection Panel for the Ottawa Police Services Board (PSB) was comprised of Councillors Eli El-Chantiry, Carol Anne Meehan and Diane Deans (PSB Chair, *ex officio*) as well as Robyn Guest (as representative of Mayor Jim Watson, *ex officio*). Their recommendation to Council for the appointment of one voting member to the Ottawa Police Services Board is listed in the Recommendation.

The Selection Panel is asking Council to waive Section 2.1 of the Appointment Policy in order to allow Mr. Smallwood to serve a four-year term given his experience and understanding on the Ottawa Police Services Board and the need to maintain continuity on the Board.
