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SUBJECT: DELEGATED AUTHORITY FOR 2021 GLOCK PURCHASE

**OBJET: DÉLÉGATION DE POUVOIRS RELATIVE À L'ACHAT DE PISTOLETS
GLOCK DEVANT ÊTRE DISTRIBUÉS EN 2021**

REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Ottawa Police Services Board approve the delegation of authority to the Chief of Police to execute and administer the immediate procurement of a sole source purchase of the 2021 Glock pistol ever-greening program allotment to a maximum of \$60,000.

RECOMMANDATIONS DU RAPPORT

Que la Commission de services policiers d'Ottawa approuve la délégation de pouvoirs au chef de police afin qu'il puisse exécuter et administrer l'achat immédiat de pistolets Glock afin qu'ils soient distribués aux policiers en 2021, dans le cadre du programme de renouvellement du cycle de vie, pour un montant maximum de 60 000 \$.

BACKGROUND

The Ottawa Police Service (OPS) annual budget includes \$60,000 for the purchase of 100 Glock pistols for the ever-greening program due to the pandemic and other world events, the current delivery lead time is three to four months.

DISCUSSION

In order to maintain operational needs there is a requirement to place orders for the 2021 allotment of Glock pistols in the 2020 budget year to ensure delivery in early 2021.

It is noteworthy for this discussion that the annual budget amount was based on a \$600 unit price. The cost is now \$724 per unit. Under current budget restraints, 82 units can be purchased for the ever-greening program.

This vendor is Rampart International Inc., which is the only authorized distributor of Glock pistols in Canada.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The costs associated are \$60,000 for the 2021 ever-greening program purchase. These funds are allocated in the 2021 OPS budget.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

CONCLUSION

It is recommended that the Board delegate authority to the Chief of Police to approve the immediate procurement of the 2021 Glock pistol allotment at the cost of \$60,000.
