Notice from Source Protection Authority under the Ontario Regulation 287/07 S. 48 1.1 (Amendments Source Protection Plan)

It is our understanding that the City of Ottawa is undergoing a project to relocate the primary intake for the Lemieux Island Water Purification Plant (WPP) within the Ottawa River.

Confirmation and Receipt of Completed Source Protection Technical Work

On Tuesday January 5, 2021, Source Protection Authority staff received the technical studies related to the Lemieux Island Intake Improvement Project to update the mapping and information in the Mississippi-Rideau Source Protection Plan and Assessment Reports.

This Notice is intended to satisfy requirements under Section 48 (1.1) (b). The Source Protection Authority is satisfied that the technical work has been completed. An amendment is advisable and will be pursued as a result of the intended application. Work is currently underway to propose an amendment to the Source Protection Plan and Assessment Reports.

We appreciate the commitment of all those involved in the completion of the technical work for the Lemieux Island Intake Improvement Project. We look forward to working with the City of Ottawa and the province on these updates.
