That Planning Committee approve the Consultation Details Section of this report be included as part of the 'brief explanation' in the Summary of Written and Oral Public Submissions, to be prepared by the City Clerk and Solicitor's Office and submitted to Council in the report titled, "Summary of Oral and Written Public Submissions for Items Subject to Bill 73 'Explanation Requirements' at the City Council Meeting of September 12, 2018" subject to submissions received between the publication of this report and the time of Council's decision.

Ann O'Connor, Planner, Planning, Infrastructure and Economic Development department responded to questions.

Committee heard two delegations:

 *Gary Ludington, Westboro Community Association, raised concerns about process and the fact that the Association's comment, made at the public meeting on this application, was omitted from the report; specifically, that it is not reasonable to ask the community to make comments on the proposal absent the design. He also raised concerns about proximity of the building footprint to

Tweedsmuir and potential safety issues for pedestrians, as well exacerbation of existing traffic issues.

 Brian Casagrande, Fotenn Consultants Inc. (applicant) noted that a detailed design is not required at this stage and that one will be prepared by the appropriate professionals if and when the plan moves forward, at which time transportation issues would also be examined.
