That Environment and Climate Protection Committee recommend Council approve the Corporate Electric Vehicle Charging Station Policy attached as Document 1.

Ms. Marica Clarke, Program Manager, Natural Systems Policy, Planning, Infrastructure and Economic Development Department (PIEDD), introduced Ms. Jennifer Brown, Project Manager, Environmental Programs, PIEDD, who spoke to a PowerPoint slide presentation which served as an overview of the report (a copy of this presentation is held on file with the City Clerk). Messrs. Stephen Willis, General Manager, PIEDD, and Mike Fletcher, Project Manager, Building Engineering and Energy Management, Recreation, Cultural and Facility Services Department, were also present to respond to questions.

The Committee heard from Mr. Matthew Eglin, who emphasized that the Policy did not offer enough key deliverables in response to what will only be a growing demand for electric vehicle charging stations throughout the City.

In response to questions from the Committee, staff explained that although certain parts of the City currently have good electrical infrastructure, other parts require significant upgrades, and that work will be ongoing, as will dialogue with the City's key partners (i.e., Hydro Ottawa). Asked whether there will be further opportunities for public input, Mr. Willis said that this policy, based on best practices, will be monitored and reviewed regularly. Staff agreed to take as Direction a request to report back in a year's time with an update on the Strategy.

Discussions having concluded, the report recommendations were put before Committee and were "CARRIED" as presented.
