## **MOTION**

Moved by Councillor George Darouze

Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee (ARAC) approve the addition of this Item for consideration by the Committee at the November 23, 2017 ARAC Meeting, pursuant to Section 89(3) of the Procedure By-Law, as the By-law in question (Temporary All-Terrain Vehicles and Other Vehicles) is going to expire prior to the next ARAC Meeting.

WHEREAS the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee (ARAC) approved a bylaw on June 26, 2013 permitting the use of all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) on City of Ottawa roads and road allowances in Osgoode Ward on a trial basis (By-law 2013-199); and

WHEREAS on November 25, 2015, Council approved an extension to the trial period and modifications to the by-law; and

WHEREAS the by-law will expire on November 23, 2017 and, to formalize the trial, staff must report back to ARAC with an evaluation of the pilot program; and

WHEREAS the staff report will not be completed before the trial expires, yet staff and the Ward Councillor support the continuation of the program on a temporary basis;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the trial be extended until January 31, 2019, prior to which time, staff will provide an evaluation report to ARAC that will include a review of how other rural municipalities have approached ATV use.
