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# BACKGROUND

Protecting Our Community's Health: Ottawa Public Health's 2019-2022 Strategy was approved by the Board of Health for the City of Ottawa in June of 2019. In December of 2019, the Board of Health received an <u>update</u> on progress made since the approval of the Strategy. At that meeting, the Board of Health made a request to receive quarterly updates on progress made towards the Strategic Plan. As a result of COVID-19 and the extensive response implemented by OPH to protect Ottawa's population, progress towards OPH's strategic goals and initiatives has been significantly impacted.
