HE PARKED HIS MARKED SUV AND APPROACHED ME AND ASKED WHERE I WAS GOING. WHEN I TOLD HIM HE SAID HE WOULD TAKE ME HOME. HE LOADED THE WALKER I WAS USING BECAUSE OF SOME OF MY DISABILITIES AND DROVE ME HOME. I'M LIKE TO THANK MY HERO. IN ALL OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES I NEGLECTED TO ASK HIS NAME. HE SAVED MY LIFE BY GOING ABOVE AND BEYOND THE CALL OF DUTY. IT'S UNLIKELY YOU'D HEAR ABOUT IAN KEMP OR HE'D RECEIVE AN AWARD FOR HIS ACTIONS. I CHOSE TO HIGHLIGHT THIS EXAMPLE AS THE TYPE OF

THE STATIONERY PROCEEDED TO HOST A PANCAKE BREAKFAST RAISING 2,000 DOLLARS FOR THE FAMILY. SINCE THEN THE FIREFIGHTERS CONTINUE TO VISIT THE FAMILY. THESE ACTIONS SUPPORTED THE FAMILY DURING A DIFFICULT TIME AND REFLECT THE DEDICATION OF THE FIRE SERVICE TO OUR RESIDENTS AND TO THE GENEROSITY OF OUR ENTIRE COMMUNITY. TODAY WE HAVE LIEUTENANT SCOTTMORPHY AND STEPHEN LOCAL REPRESENTING STATION 84. I ASK THEY STAND UP TO BE RECOGNIZED. (Applause)

THE CORONER'S OFFICE, EMERGENCY ROOMS ON OVERDOSE PREVENTION. WE'VE BEEN MONITORING DEVELOPMENTS ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND HAVE CONFIDENCE THAT THANKS TO THEIR PUBLIC AWARENESS EFFORTS AND LEADERSHIP, THE OVERDOSE TASK FORCE, OUR HEALTH DEPARTMENT ARE ACTIVELY ENGAGED TO ADDRESS THE SITUATION LOCALLY. I'D LIKE TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO THANK THE HEALTH BOARD CHAIR, AND THE CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER OF HEALTH FOR THEIR DEDICATION TO THIS ISSUE. THE CITY IS NOT ONLY PREPARING FOR AN INCREASE IN VISITORS, WE'RE ALSO PREPARING FOR A CHANGE IN DEMOGRAPHICS. OUR AGING POPULATION WILL BE A SIGNIFICANT STORY IN 2017 WITH THE SHARE OF THE POPULATION THAT IS 65 AND OVER EXPECTED TO INCREASE FROM ABOUT 13% TO 21%. THIS IS PLAYING A KEY ROLE IN OUR COMMITMENT TO INTENSIFICATION AND MAKING OUR PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE FULLY ACCESSIBLE. WE'LL BE INVESTING TO CREATE AN AGE FRIENDLY OTTAWA.

  FEW MONTHS, I WILL BE HOSTING THE 11th ANNUAL FRANCOPHONE
  BREAKFAST AT CITY OF OTTAWA HALL.

I'M LOOKING FORWARD TO DISCUSSING THIS ISSUE WITH MY COLLEAGUES AND THE PUBLIC SO WE CAN MOVE AHEAD WITH THE PROCUREMENT OF THE NEXT PHASE OF LRT. OTTAWA WILL BE THE ONLY CITY IN CANADA WHERE A NEW LINE IS BEING COMMISSIONED FOR REVENUE SERVICE AT THE SAME TIME AS THE EXPANSIONS WILL GO UNDER CONSTRUCTION. WE'RE NOT MERELY SHOVEL READY. WE'RE BUILDING NOW AND FULLY MOBILIZED AND WE HAVE A CLEAR PLAN TO CONTINUE TO ADVANCE THE AGENDA. ONCE OPERATIONAL, THE TRAIN SYSTEM COMPRISED OF THE CONFEDERATION LINE EAST WEST AND THE TRILLIUM LINE WILL SPAN OVER 50 KILOMETRES OF RAIL AND INCLUDE 39 STATIONS.

WHILE ON THE SUBJECT, I'M PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE FOLLOWING THE SUCCESS OF THE SCHOOL COMPETITION TO NAME OUR ROAD HEADERS, WE'LL BE HAVING A COMPETITION AT OUR SCHOOLS TO NAME OTTAWA'S LRT ENGINE ON THE NEW LINE. INFORMATION WILL BE SEND TO COUNCILLORS AND SCHOOLS IN THE FALL OF THIS YEAR. WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN THE SPRING OF 2018. I LOOK FORWARD TO SEEING OUR CREATIVE YOUNG MINDS COME UP WITH NEW NAMES. I ASKED COUNCILLORS TO COORDINATE. THE LRT WILL CHANGE THE LAND USE PLANNING TO PROMOTE MORE DENSITY AROUND STATIONS. OUR INTENSIFICATION STRATEGY FOR RESIDENTIAL

DEVELOPMENT IS WORKING VERY WELL. THERE ARE ABOUT 47 HOUSING STARTS LAST YEAR. OF THOSE A RECORD 58% OF NEW HOUSING AND URBAN AND SUBURBAN AREAS WAS DEVELOPED. NEW HOUSING BUILT IN TARGET AREAS SUCH AS RAPID TRANSIT STATIONS ACCOUNTED FOR A RECORD 41% OF THE NEW UNITS. THE CITY IS COMMITTED TO TRANSIT ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT. FOR EXAMPLE, IN JUST THE PROPERTIES AROUND HEARDMAN, LEES, ST. LAURENT, THERE'S POTENTIAL FOR HOUSES TO BE BUILT ALONG WITH RETAIL OPPORTUNITIES TO PROVIDE THE COMMUNITIES WITH BETTER JOBS. WE KNOW THAT THIS WILL TAKE MANY YEARS TO UNFOLD. BUT I THINK IT'S VERY EXCITING THAT OUR BUSINESS COMMUNITY IS PREPARED TO INVEST IN TRANSIT ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT.

TRINITY DEVELOPMENT IS PROPOSING A MAJOR DEVELOPMENT AT 900 ALBERT STREET WITH THREE MIXED USE TOWERS STEPS AWAY FROM THE BAY VIEW LRT STATION. WE'LL CREATE A LARGE NEW NEIGHBOURHOOD AT THE HEART OF THE SYSTEM. THE DEVELOPMENT INCLUDES A 1600 UNIT 5 TOWER COMPLEX AIMED AT MIXED INCOME HOUSEHOLDS AND A GROCERY STORE FOR THE DOWNTOWN. 2017 NEW AFFORDABLE HOUSING WILL BE OPEN. THESE INCLUDE 455 VIA VERONA. A 98 UNIT AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMMUNITY FOR FAMILIES. CARRUTHERS AVENUE. AND 1900 ST. JOSEPH BOULEVARD FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO EXPERIENCE CHRONIC HOMELESSNESS. I WANT TO THANK COUNCILLOR MARK TAYLOR FOR HIS GREAT WORK ON THESE ISSUES. NEXT MONTH WE'LL CONTINUE THE DIALOGUE ON THE PROPOSED SITE FOR THE NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY IN COUNCILLOR McKENNY'S AWARD.
- >> Voice of Interpreter: LIKE MANY OF YOU, I BELIEVE THIS IS AN EXTREMELY IMPORTANT CITY BUILDING MOMENT.
- >> HAVE BEEN WORKING HARD TO ENSURE THE NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY WILL BE A RESOUNDING SUCCESS. I'M OF THE VIEW LIKE LANSDOWNE, OUR LIBRARY WILL BE A PEOPLE PLACE, ONE THAT RESIDENTS FROM STITTSVILLE, CUMBERLAND, BEACON HILL, CENTRE TOWN WILL COME TO ENJOY. THE CITY WILL BE CHALLENGED THIS YEAR TO GUIDE THE DEVELOPMENT OF NEW

SUBURBS AND THE GRADUATE EVOLUTION OF EXISTING ONES IN A WAY THAT MAINTAINS RESIDENTIAL ATTRIBUTES. AS EXISTING SUBURBS MATURE. THE AREAS HAVE SEEN GREATER DEMOGRAPHICS. ONE INITIALIVE IS THE BUILDING BETTER SUBURBS INITIATIVE. THIS IS A PRACTICAL EXAMPLE OF HOW WE CAN ENHANCE OUR SUBURBS FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS BY MAKING THE COMMUNITIES MORE LAND EFFICIENT, AFFORDABLE, MORE LIVABLE. FOLLOWING THE INITIAL INSPECTIONS, FORMAL ACTIONS WILL BE PURSUED TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE TO BETTER PRESERVE HERITAGE ELEMENTS OF EXISTING PROPERTIES. OTTAWA ALSO RECOGNIZES THE IMPORTANCE OF PROTECTING NATURAL LANDSCAPES. IN 2017 WE'LL COMPLETE THE URBAN FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN THAT WILL PROVIDE A LONG-TERM VISION FOR THE URBAN FOREST AND ENSURE IT'S HEALTHY AND ROBUST FOR THE YEARS TO COME. THIS YEAR THE ENERGY EVOLUTION PROJECT WILL SUPPORT CATALYST PROJECTS TO DEMONSTRATE OTTAWA'S COLLABORATION WITH PARTNERS IN ADVANCING ENERGY CONSERVATION. FISH EFFICIENCY.

THE COMPANY'S FIRST SUCCESS WAS THE DIZZY FIX THAT HELPS PATIENTS RECOVER FROM VERTIGO. OTTAWA'S CLIP FOLIO ANNOUNCED AN INVESTMENT TO HELP EXPAND BUSINESSES AND HIRE NEW STAFF. CLIP FOLIO MAKES SOFTWARE TO ALLOW COMPANIES TO MONITOR SALES. HANDLE SHIPPING AND INVENORY. IN BLACKBERRY WHO ANNOUNCED A 100 MILLION DOLLAR INVESTMENT AND 650 NEW JOBS IN OTTAWA, IT'S NO WANDER APPLE HAS SET UP AN OFFICE TO LEAD THE CHARGE ON AUTONOMOUS VEHICLES. THE MIX OF TECHNOLOGY IN OTTAWA WITH THE MAJOR AUTOMANUFACTURERS IN THE GREATER TORONTO AREA IS SETTING UP OTTAWA FOR A PROMISING YEAR IN 2017. THAT'S WHY IN A FEW WEEKS I'LL LEAD A MISSION TO QUEEN'S PARK TO SHOWCASE THE GREAT WORK THAT IS BEING DONE IN OTTAWA AND EXPLORE HOW WE CAN LEVERAGE OUR LOCAL HIGH TECH SECTOR TO DEVELOP 5G IN SUPPORT OF AUTONOMOUS VEHICLE INDUSTRY IN ONTARIO. WHERE THERE'S A GAP IN THE HOUSING FIRST POLICY WHERE 100% OF THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF A PROPERTY THAT IS ZONED INSTITUTIONAL ARE DIRECTED TO THE CITY WIDE RESERVE FUND WHICH IS NOT CONSISTENT WITH THE POLICY'S GOALS AND WHERE IT CAN INCLUDE SENIORS AND LONG-TERM RESIDENCE AND GROUP HOMES. THE POLICY IS UNDER REVIEW AND INCLUDING A PROVISION FOR THE PORTION OF SALES FOR CITY PROPERTIES. WHEREAS ADDRESSING THIS GAP IN THE POLICY WILL INCREASE THE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE HOUSING RESERVE FUND ON AN ANNUAL BASIS. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT CITY DIRECT HOUSING SERVICES STAFF TO CONDUCT A REVIEW OF ALL ZONES THAT COULD BE INCLUDED IN THEIR REPORT TO REFRESH THE POLICY TO INCLUDE A PROVISION TO THE PORTION OF SALES OF PROPERTIES ZONE INSTITUTIONAL AND USED FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES FOR CONSIDERATION BY COUNCIL AT THAT TIME AND THESE ADDITIONAL PLANS BE USED FOR CAPITAL. MR. MAYOR, EVER SO BRIEFLY, WE ALL KNOW THAT HOUSING, AFFORDABLE HOUSING, IS A HIGH PRIORITY. THIS MOTION IS DESIGNED TO ENSURE THAT WE GET SOME EXTRA CAPITAL DOLLARS INTO OUR CAPITAL FUND. AS MOST OF YOU WILL RECALL. IN 2015, DURING THE BUDGET, WE AGREED TO REMOVE THE 4 MILLION DOLLAR CONTRIBUTION TO CAPITAL. IT WAS INTENDED TO BE TEMPORARY BUT IT HAS NOT BEEN PUT BACK. SO I'M LOOKING FOR MEANS TO REPLENISH THAT FUND AND GET VERY IMPORTANT CAPITAL DOLLARS. I THINK THIS IS ONE AVENUE. IT SHOULDN'T BE THE ONLY AVENUE. BUT I THINK IT'S ONE AVENUE. I ASK THAT YOU SUPPORT THAT. MR. MAYOR, I'D LIKE TO CALL FOR A RECORDED VOTE ON THIS ISSUE. A RECORDED VOTE.
