REPORT RECOMMENDATION

That the Finance and Economic Development Committee recommend Council approve the appointment of Justin Lemieux to the Bank Street Business Improvement Area Board of Management for the term expiring November 30, 2018.

BACKGROUND

Section 204 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 requires that the municipality appoint BIA Board members. At its 3 February 2015 meeting, City Council approved the appointments of members to the various Business Improvement Area (BIA) Management Boards in the City.

DISCUSSION

In an e-mail dated September 25, 2017, the City Clerk and Solicitor's Office was notified of the appointment of Vinod Chaudhary to fill a vacancy on its Board of Management and requested that Council approve the appointment of one (1) member.

Section 204 of the *Municipal Act* directs that Business Improvement Area Board members shall hold office until the expiration of the term of Council that appoints them. The new appointee will therefore serve until November 30, 2018.
