REPORT RECOMMENDATION

That the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee recommend Council approve Appendix A, Section 3.

Chair Moffatt summarized quickly the process for the Term of Council Priorities and that a PowerPoint presentation was given at the Finance and Economic Development Committee when it was tabled. He stated that the section for ARAC is relatively small but that much more affects the rural residents through the various other Standing Committees such as roads (Transportation), community centres, fire services, parks (Community and Protective Services), etc...

The Committee members had various questions such as:

 It appears that less is being spent on roads and the rural area has a large network. Where is the sections not covered? Staff: The Transportation Master Plan

 Storm management and culverts which at some point had already been paid for under various municipalities and paid for by those residents.
 How is it covered now? Staff: This will all form part of treasurer's rate review.

The Committee members would like to see an information report on what is covered under the various other Standing Committees that affect the rural residents.
