In response to a question raised by Vice-Chair Tierney regarding an outstanding appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB), Tim Marc, Senior Legal Counsel, Planning, Development and Real Estate, Office of the City Clerk and Solicitor clarified that since the time this report was written, the OMB appeal from the Committee of Adjustment had been withdrawn.

Mr. Murray Chown, Novatech, and Ms. Kelly Rhodenizer and Mr. Cal Kirkpatrick, Colonnade BridgePort, were present in support of the staff recommendation but opted not to speak when the Chair indicated the Committee was prepared to carry the item on consent.
