Ms Shelley McDonald, Acting Director, Solid Waste Services, Public Works and Environmental Services Department (PWES), thanked colleagues Jason Staniforth, Manager, Waste Processing and Disposal, PWES, and Anthony Brown, Program Coordinator, Recycling and Material Diversion, PWES, as well as staff in Legal Services and Finance Services for helping to bring this proposal forward for Council's consideration. She then provided the Committee with a slide presentation overview of the report. A copy of this presentation is held on file with the City Clerk.

Committee discussions and questions to staff touched upon, but were not necessarily limited to: the origins of the proposed partnership with North Grenville; exploring opportunities to partner with other small municipalities; questions of Ottawa's, and its partner facilities' capacities, limits and abilities to take on additional organic material for processing; program benefits and savings; the positive aspects of waste diversion, encouraging greater leaf, yard waste and organics recycling in Ottawa, and; opportunities for other smaller
