- 1. That Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee recommend Council approve amendments to Zoning By-law 2008-250, as shown in Document 1 and detailed in Documents 3 and 4.**
- 2. That the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee approve the Consultation Details Section of this report be included as part of the 'brief explanation' in the Summary of Written and Oral Public Submissions, to be prepared by the Office of the City Clerk and submitted to Council in the report titled, "Summary of Oral and Written Public Submissions for Items Subject to the *Planning Act* 'Explanation Requirements' at the City Council Meeting of October 14, 2020", subject to submissions received between the publication of this report and the time of Council's decision.**

Councillor Moffatt noted that waiting for the new Official Plan is lengthy and impacting many properties because they don't have consistent zoning. Many changes with regards to the LEER have yet to be made.

Don Herweyer, Director, Economic Development and Long Range Planning responded by stating that the comprehensive zoning by-law is about two or three or even four years away. Staff will get back to the Councillor on items he mentioned.

The report recommendations were put to Committee and CARRIED as presented.
