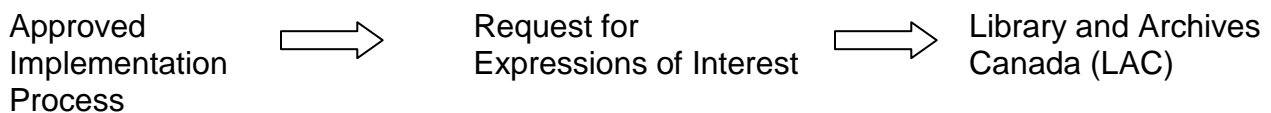
Central Library Development Project Update

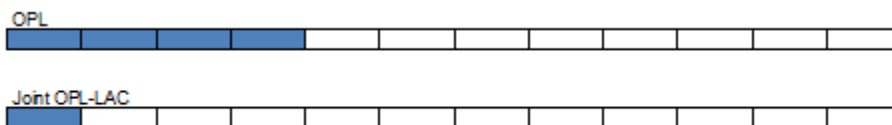
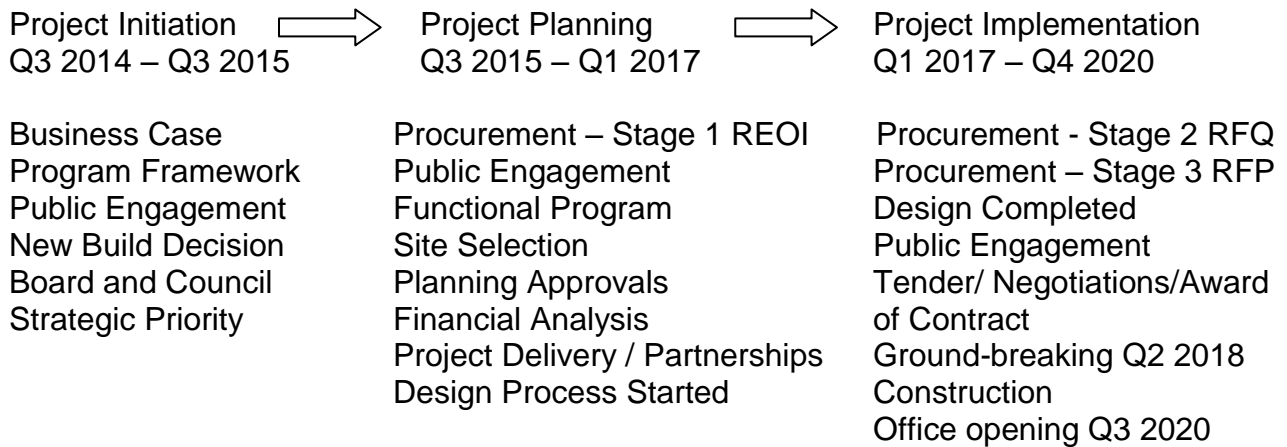
