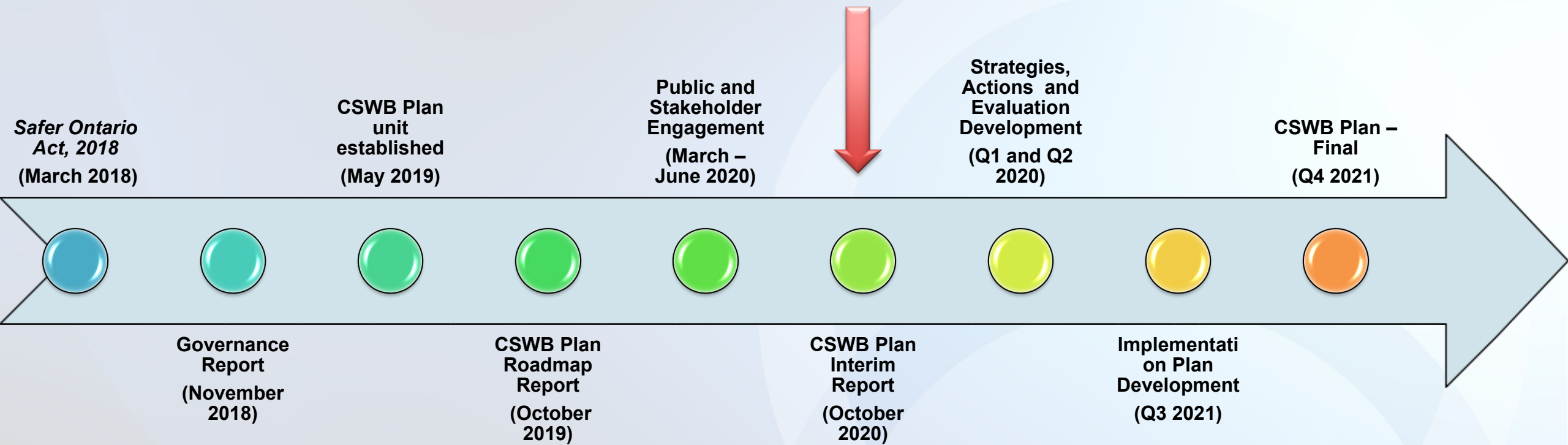

Legislative Requirements

The municipality must:

- Prepare and adopt a plan
- Establish an advisory committee
- Consult with the public and stakeholders
- Consider multiple sources of data and information on risk factors
- Implement the Plan
- Evaluate the Plan



Key Elements of CSWB Planning

- Take a social determinants of health approach
- Address key priorities and reduce risk factors and root causes of crime, social disorder and ill-health
- Use a multi-sectoral, collective impact approach
- Focus on shared goals and outcomes
- Complement existing initiatives and identify and address gaps

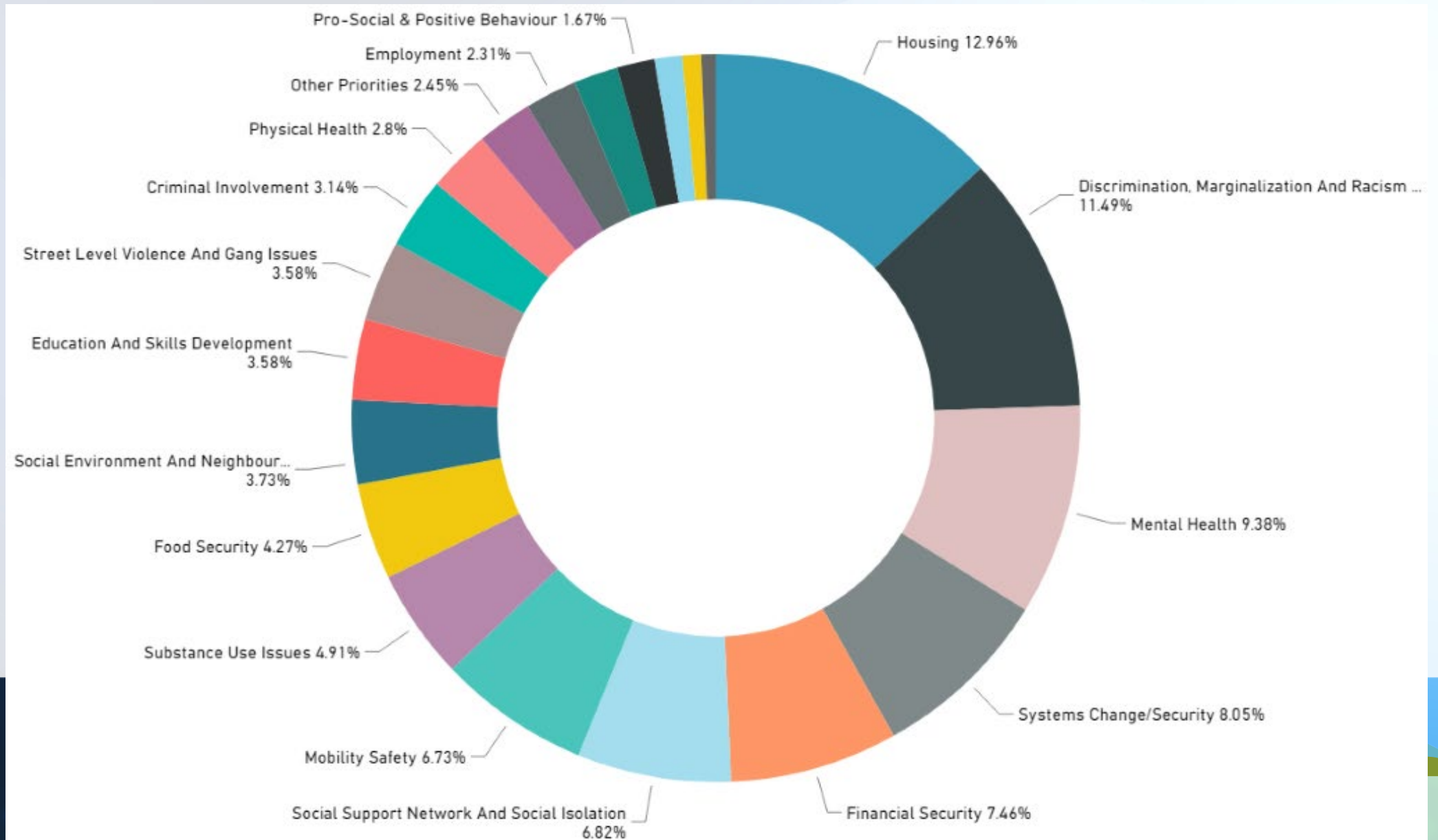

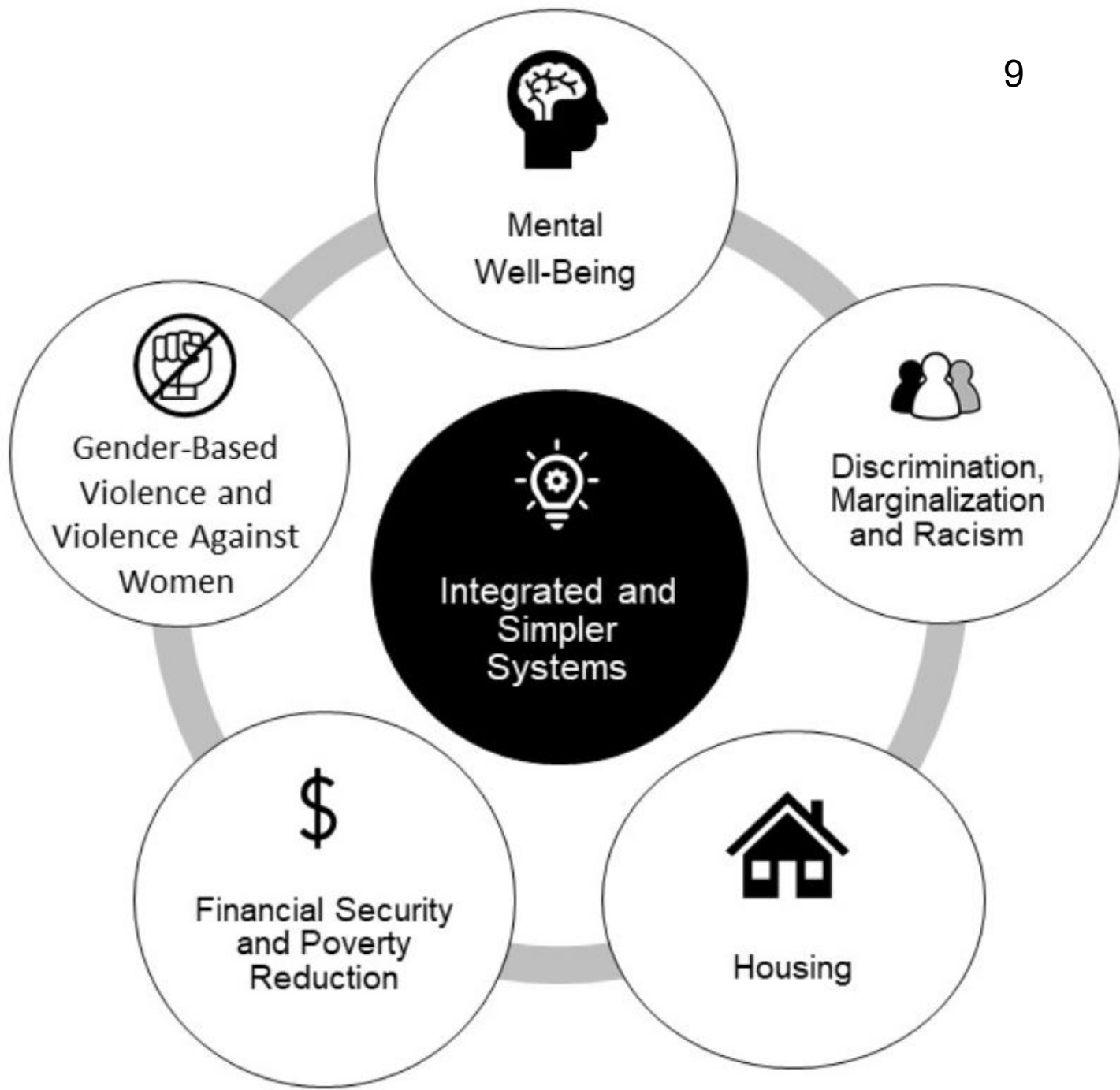
