## **Report recommendations**

That the Planning Committee:

- 1. Recommend that Council endorse the proposed settlement with the appellants of the Significant Woodlands policies approved by Council on 14 December 2016, as described in this report.
- 2. Recommend that Council approve the attached Document 1, Significant Woodlands: Guidelines for Identification, Evaluation, and Impact Assessment [Significant Woodlands Guidelines].
- 3. Direct the Planning, Infrastructure, and Economic Development staff to initiate a review of the implementation of the Significant Woodlands Guidelines within three years of approval.

Nick Stow, Planner, and Geraldine Wildman, Program Manager, Resiliency and Natural Systems Policy, of the Planning, Infrastructure and Economic Development department were present to provide comment and respond to questions. Mr. Stow provided a memo to the Committee on February 26, enclosing eight public submissions, and the staff responses to them, that had been considered in the preparation of the report but were accidentally omitted from Document 3. A copy of the memo is held on file.

The committee heard one delegation:

• Paul Johanis, Chair, Greenspace Alliance of Canada's Capital<sup>1</sup>, noted some

concerns regarding wording around the new definition of tree, and about how significant woodlands will be treated in future urban expansions, but supported the adoption of the guidelines and did not object to the proposed settlement because of the greater gain of recognition of the social and cultural value of urban woodlands and the rigor provided by the guidelines in how to apply this principle.
