OVERVIEW



- COVID 19 Pandemic response represents a major financial risk for the 2020 OPS Budget
- OPS Command team will provide monthly updates to the Board through FAC
- Significant financial controls already implemented totaling \$12.9M in expense savings
 - Incident Command System with full financial tracking
 - Discretionary spending freeze and travel ban
 - Employee transfer and temporary assignment freeze
 - Enhanced OT reporting and controls
- April forecast deficit range from \$1.4M to \$5.9M

UPDATES



- Additional options identified to reduce deficit..prioritized based on the following principles:
 - Continue to provide police operations
 - Protect health and safety of our members
 - Maintain capacity to deliver policing operations
 - Protect our community and sustainability of our health care system
 - Maintain public confidence
 - Financial sustainability
- Exec Command made decision to implement 2 options resulting in \$3M of savings
- City direction on reduced red light camera revenue
- Updated forecast with April results
- Full year deficit reduced from \$5.9M to \$0.7M
